DISCUSSION

Summerland Sanitary District (Discharger) owns and operates a wastewater collection and treatment system. The Discharger disposes of its treated wastewater to the Pacific Ocean through an outfall-diffuser system originating at the Summerland Sanitary District wastewater treatment plant.

CHANGES FROM THE EXISTING ORDER

The proposed Order is structured in accordance with the statewide NPDES permit template. The proposed Order is consistent with the previous Order with the exception of the following substantive changes/modifications:

- New permit order number, associated permit adoption, effective, and expiration dates;
- Added references to the most recent Ocean Plan edition;

- Clarified the table identifying sampling frequency and electronic self-monitoring reporting requirements; and
- Added the 2013 Water Board Standard Provisions for NPDES permits.

COMMENTS

Central Coast Water Board staff did not receive comments on the draft permit during the 30-day public comment period.

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Order No. R3-2013-0042, as proposed.
