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DISCUSSION

Violations Listing

Staff uses the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) to track Water Board data, including violations and enforcement actions. Attachment 1 is a CIWQS list of violations by dischargers between April 1, 2014, and May 31, 2014. Attachment 1.a is a separate list of violations by enrollees regulated by the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program Agricultural Order between June 1, 2014, and July 31, 2014. CIWQS has a sewer system overflow (SSO) module that provides tracking and reporting of such spills.

Significant or Notable Violations

- California Men's Colony, San Luis Obispo County. The listing includes 21 violations for CMC of various types, including total nitrogen, pH, and salts. Plant staff made operational changes to resolve nitrogen problems and recent values are within limits. The plant has switched from chlorine disinfection to ultraviolet light, so there have not been any more violations of limits for chlorination byproducts.

Summary of Enforcement Activities

The following information summarizes significant enforcement actions taken by the Water Board during the period between June 1, 2014, and July 31, 2014.
