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DISCUSSION

### **Violations Listing**

Water Board staff uses the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) to track Water Board data, including violations and enforcement actions. Attachment 1 is a CIWQS list of violations by dischargers between August 1, 2014 and October 31, 2014. CIWQS has a sewer system overflow (SSO) module that provides tracking and reporting of such spills.

### **Summary of Enforcement Activities**

Attachment 1 lists violations and discharger follow-up actions. This list is incomplete due to staff being redirected to work on other high priority projects such as the Cambria drought emergency permits and the City of Santa Barbara's desalination permit. In the future, unless directed otherwise by the Water Board, staff will provide routine enforcement reports every other Board meeting. This frequency is more reasonable since the enforcement reports do not change significantly from Board meeting to Board meeting, and staff will continue to summarize any significant enforcement actions at every Board meeting.

The following information summarizes significant enforcement actions taken by the Water Board during the period between October 1, 2014 and November 30, 2014.
