- Many unaware of poor water quality and nitrate contamination
- A sense that there are no options
 - Not considered a DAC at the census tract level
 - Mixed income area yet 90% of participants self-report being either migrant and/or agricultural workers
 - Renters vs. owners
 - "When will we get clean water?"

- UC Hastings
 - Legal entity formation as part of a long-term solution
 - Johnson Road
- Work with local health care providers to assess patients with water quality and sanitation issues.
- Lack of support from local/County government and elected officials
 - EJCW partners
 - Safe Drinking Water participants
