Assessment Protocol and Goals

YEAR ONE

- Initial costs of \$100,000 absorbed by group of 20 individual companies, not sought or received reimbursement.
- Original Assessment beginning March 29, 2017 was determined by estimating expenses and number of known members (20).
- Now that budget is consistent, assessments have been suspended for all members.

YEAR TWO

- Year Two Assessment Structure Has Been Approved based on actual one year of operating history and total membership.
 - ▶ \$500 flat charge for all members below 250 acres
 - ▶ \$4.00 per acre charge
- Result in significant cost savings for all members

Hardships- Executive committee has offered to consider financial hardships whenever any financial hardships are known or brought to attention.

Communication Protocol

- Executive Committee Initially met weekly, currently meets Bi-Weekly.
- ▶ Open invitation to all members to attend.
- ▶ Minutes provided to all members post meeting.
- Quarterly all member meeting.
- ▶ Weekly reports from Cures to Subcommittee.
- Outreach and engagement with Trade groups. Biweekly update meetings.
- ► Coordination with Agreement Parties-Quarterly written report and weekly teleconferences, currently on as needed basis with SWRCB and CCRWQCB.

Satisfaction Of Agreement Goals

SBASG is obligated to use all commercially reasonable steps to provide replacement water to a minimum of 35 systems. (See Section 2.3 of the Interim Replacement Water Settlement Agreement).
