

 - Glez Farms


Elkhorn Road (Watsonville) – Locator Map





Francisco Rocha Farms – Sediment Basin and Runoff Patterns







Francisco Rocha Farms - Summary

- Discharger has not submitted Farm Plan
- Discharger has not submitted Technical Reporting
- Sediment basin is significantly undersized and in need of maintenance
- Reported ranch fumigation the morning of 2nd site visit
- Risk of future sediment discharges high

Glez Farms – Summary

- Submitted updated Farm Plan
- Submitted sediment basin system design plans
- Multiple BMPS to manage sediment
- Contend sediment basin system is adequate
- Contend road failures and downed trees led to majority of sediment discharges
- Some Technical Reporting is past due
- Risk of future sediment discharges low


- Follow up on past due technical and monitoring reporting
