## SUMMARY OF OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES

Staff presented Ag Order 4.0 requirement options at the November 8-9, 2018 board meeting. The board and public also heard presentations from the California Strawberry Commission and a consortium of agricultural advocates lead by Grower-Shipper Association of Central California and Central Coast Groundwater Coalition.

Since the November 2018 board meeting, staff lead public stakeholder meetings at:

- Watsonville Public Library on November 27, 2018
- U.C. Cooperative Extension in Salinas on November 28, 2018
- Farm Bureau of San Luis Obispo County on November 29, 2018
- Santa Maria Public Library on November 30, 2018
- Agricultural Liaison Advisory Board in San Luis Obispo on December 3, 2018
- Wine Growers Alliance in Paso Robles on December 13, 2018

Staff has had focused stakeholder meetings with:

- Dr. Lowell Zelinski on January 28, 2019
- Ag Organization representatives from Grower Shipper Association, Monterey County Farm Bureau, Farm Bureau Federation and Central Coast Groundwater Coalition in King City on February 19, 2019

Staff regularly update the log of Ag Order 4.0-related discussions with external stakeholders.

On November 19, 2018, staff solicited written public comment on the conceptual options tables. The public comment period was originally scheduled to close on January 18, 2019 and was later extended to January 22, 2019. In the public comment notice, staff provided additional guidance on comments solicited related to the five conceptual options tables, as well as other information relevant to the Ag Order 4.0 development process. Staff solicited input on prioritization and phasing, numeric limits, time schedule to achieve numeric limits, monitoring and reporting, incentives, consequences, CEQA, costs, and alternative options.
