NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE OF FILING A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

Concerning an Amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin to Adopt a Total Maximum Daily Load for Total Phosphorus in Pinto Lake and an Associated TMDL Implementation Plan

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Coast Water Board) will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of a resolution amending the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) and adopting Substitute Environmental Documentation (SED) prepared to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). If the resolution is adopted, the Basin Plan will be amended to incorporate a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for total phosphorus and an associated TMDL Implementation Plan to address cyanobacterial blooms in Pinto Lake, Santa Cruz County.

The Central Coast Water Board's Basin Planning Program is considered a certified regulatory program, which means that the Board is exempt from the CEQA requirement to prepare an environmental impact report for basin planning activities. (Pub. Res. Code, § 21080.5; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251(g).) The Board's environmental review of the proposed Basin Plan amendment is instead contained in the CEQA Analysis and Environmental Checklist document, which is part of the SED.
