Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to re-stabilize the road prism in spot locations and improve drainage conditions to protect the roadway from future floods.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replacing two 18-inch diameter culverts and installing riprap protection at the outlets; • Installing a gabion wall and stabilizing the bottom with riprap; • Resurfacing the patched section of the road with pavement and curb; • Creating a low-water crossing or rolling dip by lowering the grade about 1 foot; • Cleaning and clearing the culvert and surrounding area of debris and excess vegetation; and • Replacing signs and performing delineator and gate installation along the road and shoulders. <p>No mitigation is proposed.</p>
