## **Project Description:**

The purpose of the proposed Project is to replace culverts that have exceeded design life, deteriorated, or failed.

The proposed project activities include:

- Replacing a 43-foot by 30-inch corrugated steel pipe with a new reinforced concrete pipe of the same dimensions using cut and cover method;
- Removing and replacing the existing inlet headwall with a series of drainage inlets;
- Replacing a 106-foot by 30-inch corrugated steel pipe with a multi-segment pipe of the same diameter using cut and cover method;
- Installing a new headwall and a 4.5-foot by 4.5-foot section of RSP with gravel filter;
- Replacing a 54-foot by 24-inch corrugated steel pipe with a reinforced concrete pipe of the same dimensions using cut and cover method; and
- Replacing existing headwalls at both the inlet and outlet.

No mitigation is proposed.
