The following is submitted to update, and supplement our previous responses to the proposed Lease and Permit order.

We request that all of our previous submissions (dated 02-25-06, 03-30-06, 06-21-06, 07-21-06, 08-15-06,) be incorporated, along with this letter, and included as a part of our response as submitted. \*(SEE PAGE 3)

We strongly feel that we have "followed the rules" as we understand them. Our property has a functioning septic system that was approved and permitted by the County of San Luis Obispo. Our system was pumped and inspected on November 3, 2006, and found to be in proper working order. Therefore, we are not "dischargers". We are in compliance with current requirements and are not "guilty" as confessed by communications from the RWQCB. We are not criminals!

The apparent expectations of the RWQCB as expressed in the CDOs are not realistic. My wife and I are not the community of Los Osos. We are individuals and alone, cannot build a sewage treatment system no matter how much we would like to see one in place.

As previously stated, we are not opposed to the installation of a sewage treatment system and would commit to a community-wide system within six months after the system is operational and available. It is our understanding that such a formal agreement is being discussed by community and RWQCB representatives.

Our long term support of installation of a system is reflected by the fact that we pre-paid our property assessment in August of 2004. We hoped that this would facilitate an earlier completion of a system. We do not consider ourselves to be non-cooperative or obstructive.
