The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) transmitted a letter containing the revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Water Reclamation Requirements (WRRs) for the Camrosa Water District's (CWD) Camrosa Water Reclamation Facility (Camrosa WRF) on September 20, 2019.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Water Board at a public hearing held on October 10, 2019, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, and considered all the factors in the case, and adopted WDRs and WRRs Order No. **R4-2019-0118**.
