TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—KINDER MORGAN LIQUIDS TERMINALS LLC (KMLT), KMLT LOS ANGELES HARBOR TERMINAL (BERTHS 119 & 120), 2200 JOHN S. GIBSON, WILMINGTON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-10036)

Dear Mr. Martin:

In our letter dated March 19, 2014, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2013-0095, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, (General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004), which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On December 14, 2015, you informed the Regional Board that construction dewatering activities have been completed and the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On December 17, 2015, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface water. Therefore, coverage under Board Order R4-2013-0095 for the subject site is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
