TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS- WELL No. 22, 4900 BLOCK OF BRADLEY RD., SOMIS, CA (NPDES No. CAG994004, CI-10244)

Dear Ms. Schoen:

In our letter dated June 23, 2016, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2013-0095, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 6, 2013.

Your consultant Intera, Inc.'s e-mail on October 17, 2016, to Regional Water Board staff requested termination of your coverage under the general NPDES permit, Order No. R4-2013-0095. The e-mail indicated the dewatering general permit is no longer necessary because Well No. 22 had been developed.

Regional Water Board staff verified through your consultant that drilling and developing of Well No. 22 has been completed and that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2013-0095, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, CI-10244 for the 25-acre lemon farm, Well No. 22 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
