RESCISSION OF NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR RAYNE WATER SYSTEMS OF VENTURA, VENTURA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0002658, ORDER NO. R4-2002-0105, CI-3070)

Dear Mr. Nancarrow:

Our letter dated March 9, 2007, enclosed a copy of a tentative Order which would rescind the subject requirements and NPDES permit.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on May 3, 2007, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2007-0027 (copy attached) relative to the rescission.

As stipulated in the March 9, 2007 letter, since storm water is the only waste stream that will continue to be present at the facility; Rayne Water Systems of Ventura is required to enroll in the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. 97-03-DWQ NPDES General Permit No. CAS000001 (General Permit), Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Discharges of Storm Water Associated with Industrial Activities Excluding Construction Activities. Please contact Harumi Goya at (213) 620-2283 to ensure that you are properly enrolled in the General Permit.

Please notify this Regional Board if future changes in facility operations would result in a discharge of wastewater to surface waters. If wastewater discharges are initiated, Rayne Water Systems of Ventura must submit a Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) to the Regional Board as a permit application.

ORDER No. R4-2007-0027

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for Discharger listed below.
- This Discharger has been enrolled under an NPDES permit or has eliminated its wastewater discharges to surface waters.
- Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
- The following Order is hereby rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.
- The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit be rescinded:

Discharger (NPDES No.)	Order No. (Adoption Date)	Reason for Rescission
Rayne Water Systems of Ventura (CA0002658)	R4-2002-0105 (May 23, 2002)	Wastewater, previously discharged to Arundell Barranca, is hauled offsite for disposal at the Santa Clara Waste Water Facility.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board, is authorized, and he is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefor, or may request same.
