## RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS, OLSEN ROAD WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0056359, CI # 4761)

Our letter dated November 14, 2002, transmitted a copy of a tentative Order which would rescind the subject requirements and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the discharge of secondary treated domestic municipal wastewater into Arroyo Santa Rosa, within Calleguas Creek Watershed.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on December 12, 2002, reviewed the tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2002-0187 (copy attached) relative to the rescission.

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
AND  
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS  
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Discharger listed below.
2. This Discharger has been enrolled under a NPDES permit or has eliminated their waste discharge to surface waters.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
4. The following Orders are hereby rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits be rescinded:
