TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ROBERTSON THEATRES CORPORATION, 120 N. ROBERSON BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-5858)

In our letter dated April 8, 2009, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your September 3, 2009 letter, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you completed the diversion of the groundwater discharge to the sanitary sewer system on July 16, 2009, and that you have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject facility to the storm drain.

On September 8, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any groundwater to surface water become necessary at the site, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
