TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CALPORTLAND COMPANY – CATALINA PACIFIC CONCRETE PLANT, TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0002992, CI-6007)

Our letter dated November 28, 2012, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for the discharge of wastewater from the Catalina Pacific Concrete Plant (Facility) located at 19030 South Normandie Avenue, Torrance, California.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), at a public hearing held on February 7, 2013, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2013-0018 (copy enclosed) relative to the termination of Order No. R4-2008-0125.

Should any future activities at the subject site result in discharges of wastewater to surface waters, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Water Board prior to discharge.
