WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – THE BOEING COMPANY, SANTA SUSANA FIELD LABORATORY, CANOGA PARK, CA, ORDER NO. R4-2010-0090, NPDES NO. CA0001309, CI NO. 6027

Our letter dated May 20, 2010, transmitted the revised-tentative Order for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 3, 2010, reviewed the revised-tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted the proposed NPDES permit with the following revisions.

- 1. Final effluent limitations were included for Outfalls 008 and 009, instead of Benchmarks (Section IV.A.2). References to Benchmarks for Outfalls 008 and 009 throughout the permit have been deleted.
- 2. Included a requirement which reads "With input from the Expert Panel, the Discharger shall submit a workplan that describes and prioritizes BMPs, including measurable milestones and implementing Interim Source Removal Action (ISRA) and Engineered Natural Treatment Systems (ENTS) that will resolve exceedances from Outfalls 008 and 009. This workplan will describe the siting and phasing of BMPs." (on Page 35, Section VII.C.3.a.ii)

The adopted Order (Order R4-2010-0090) serves as an NPDES permit, and expires on April 10, 2014. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application/Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of this Order (July 19, 2010). Your first monitoring report for the period of

July 2010 is due by November 15, 2010. Monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to Compliance File Cl-6027 and NPDES No. CA0001309, which will assure that the reports, are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports, such as progress reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
