CORRECTION OF THE UNITS FOR CHLORINE, TOTAL RESIDUAL INCLUDED IN THE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT (ORDER NO R4-2011-0029) FOR MAGIC MOUNTAIN LLC, SIX FLAGS MAGIC MOUNTAIN, VALENCIA, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0003352, CI NO. 6045)

Our letter dated February 11, 2011, transmitted the Waste Discharge Requirements and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit, Order No. R4-2011-0029.

On April 20, 2011, Mr. Ray Ouellette of Kennedy/Jenks Consultants informed the Regional Water Board staff (Staff) via telephone, that Order No. R4-2011-0029 included chlorine, total residual effluent limitations with Units of " μ g/L" for Discharge Point Nos. 001, 002, and 003 instead of " μ g/L".

Staff reviewed Order No. R4-2011-0029 and confirmed that there are typographical errors of the units for chlorine, total residual in the effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, and fact sheet sections of Order No. R4-2011-0029. The units for chlorine, total residual should have been "mg/L" instead of "µg/L". The chlorine, total residual units are located in:

- (1) Table 6, page 13, Table 7, page 14, and Table 8, page 16, of the Order;
- (2) Table E-3a, page E-7, Table E-3b, page E-9, and Table E-3c, page E-10 of Attachment E Monitoring and Reporting Program; and
- (3) Table F-13a, page F-48, Table F-13b, page F-50, and F-13c, page F-51 of Attachment F Fact Sheet.

This letter corrects the units for chlorine, total residual from "µg/L" to "mg/L" in the above referenced Tables of Order No. R4-2011-0029:
