

TERMINATION OF INDIVIDUAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR TIDELANDS OIL PRODUCTION COMPANY, WILMINGTON FACILITY (PIER A WEST OIL FIELD AND TERMINAL ISLAND PIER S OIL FIELD), WILMINGTON, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0001813, CI NO. 6080)

Our letter dated January 17, 2012, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for Tidelands Oil Production Company, Wilmington Facility (Pier A West Oil Field and Terminal Island Pier S Oil Field).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Board, at a public hearing held on March 1, 2012, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2012-0056 (copy attached) relative to the termination of Order No. R4-2003-0072.

ORDER NO. R4-2012-0056

TERMINATING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

- 1. This Regional Water Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the Dischargers listed below.
- 2. The discharges to surface waters from these Facilities have been eliminated and/or are covered under the General NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity.
- 3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be terminated.
- 4. The following Orders are hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
- 5. The termination of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Water Board has notified the Dischargers, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.

Order No. R4-2012-0056 Terminating Waste Discharge Requirements and NPDES Permit

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits be terminated:

Storm water discharges are covered under the General NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity.
Harris Water Conditioning, Inc., 1371 Fleet Avenue, Ventura (CA0060267)	R4-2002-0093 (April 25, 2002), and R4-2004-0073 [Amending Order No. R4-2002-0093] (May 6, 2004)	The Facility has ceased discharging to surface waters.
The Flat (750 Garland, LLC, Former Holiday Inn) 750 Garland Avenue, Los Angeles (CA0053490)	R4-2006-0053 (July 8, 2006)	The Facility redirected the discharge of swimming pool filter backwash and pool drainage to the sanitary sewer.
