TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – THE BOEING COMPANY – LONG BEACH DIVISION, 3855 LAKEWOOD BOULEVARD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI-6116)

In our letter dated January 24, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under *Order No. R4-2004-0058, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Nonprocess Wastewaters Not Requiring Treatment Systems to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on April 1, 2004, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your August 2, 2006, letter requesting termination of coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have ceased the discharge of cooling tower bleed-off, non-contact cooling water, and boiler blowdown from the subject facility to the storm drain. In addition, the NPDES monitoring locations has also been demolished as part of property redevelopment activities.

On August 8, 2006, Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of wastewater from the subject site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0058, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994003 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
