CHANGE OF MONTHLY MONITORING REPORT DUE DATE – DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0110175, CI-6432)

Regional Board Order No. 00-090 contains Waste Discharge Requirements for your discharge of treated domestic wastewater to the Pacific Ocean from a package wastewater treatment plant, located at the Naval Auxiliary Landing Field, San Clemente Island, Los Angeles County. Under *Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 6432*, which is a part of Order No. 00-090, you are required to submit monthly monitoring reports to the Regional Board by the 15th day following the end of the month.

In your letter dated September 14, 2000, you requested a change to the monthly monitoring report due date from the 15th to the last day of the following month. You stated that the change will help alleviate air transportation and holding time problems you are experiencing. As you requested, we hereby approve a change to the deadline for submittal of monthly monitoring reports to the last day of the following month. Accordingly, your next monitoring report, for November 2000 monitoring period, must be received at the Regional Board by December 31, 2000. The schedule for submitting annual reports is not changed.
