TYPOGRAPHICAL CORRECTION FOR WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR THE UNITED STATES NAVY, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0110175, CI NO. 6432)

Dear Mr. Golumbfskie-Jones:

On November 27, 2018, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) staff transmitted Order No. R4-2018-0156, which was adopted on November 08, 2018 and serves as Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the United States Navy's San Clemente Island Wastewater Treatment Plant. The cover page of the Order specifies an expiration date of December 31, 2024; however, this would make the Order effective for longer than five years. Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) §122.46 states, "NPDES permits shall be effective for a fixed term not to exceed 5 years." Since the expiration date specified on the cover page of the Order is greater than five years from the adoption date, the Regional Water Board has determined that this was a typographical error.

Therefore, the Regional Water Board has modified Order No. R4-2018-0156, adopted by this Board on November 08, 2018, to correct this minor typographical error pursuant to 40 CFR section 122.63:

Table 3 of the cover page shall read as follows:

This Order shall expire on:	December 31, 2024 2023
The Discharger shall file a Report of Waste Discharge as an application for reissuance of WDRs in accordance with title 23, California Code of Regulations, and an application for reissuance of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit no later than:	180 days prior to the Order expiration date
The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, have classified this discharge as follows:	Minor discharge
