RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – PENNZOIL-QUAKER STATE COPORATION LOCATED AT 19501 SANTA FE AVENUE, RANCHO DOMINGUEZ (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0059480, CI-6702)

Reference is made to our letter of August 17, 1999, which included a copy of a tentative order which would rescind your NPDES permit (NPDES No. CA0059480) since the permit would be replaced by the "Industrial Activities Storm Water General Permit" for stormwater discharges (NPDES General Permit No. CAS0000011; SWRCB Water Quality Order No. 97-03-DWQ). The SWRCB letter of September 15, 1999, confirms your "Notice of Intent to Comply with the Terms of the General Permit to Discharge Storm Water Associated with Industrial Activity".

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Board at a public hearing held on September 16, 1999, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. 99-089 (copy attached) relative to the rescission.

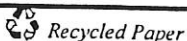

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
AND
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the dischargers listed below.
2. These Dischargers has been enrolled under a general NPDES permits.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
4. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matte .

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements be rescinded:
