REVISION OF MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – ARDEN REALTY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, NEW WILSHIRE BUILDING, 6100 WILSHIRE BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES (NPDES NO. CAG994001, CI-6806)

Dear Ms. Williams:

In our letter dated June 30, 1997, we authorized the discharge of groundwater from dewatering activity at the subject facility under Order No. 97-045; "*General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*" which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In our effort to standardize the Monitoring and Reporting Program, some changes have to be made in order to attain consistency in our requirements. The revision of the Monitoring and Reporting Program includes: 1) Sample Collection Requirements; 2) Requirements for terminating the discharge if monitoring results indicate an exceedance; 3) Requirements for accelerated monitoring following the exceedance of effluent limit; 4) Requirements for reporting the exceedance to the Regional Board.

Enclosed is the revised Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-6806 that replaces your existing Monitoring and Reporting Program. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-6806, NPDES No. CAG994001", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.
