TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—THE CENTER FOR EARLY EDUCATION, 563 N. ALFRED STREET, WEST HOLLYWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI-6832)

Discharge of treated groundwater from the subject facility was regulated under General NPDES Permit No. CAG914001, Order No. R4-2007-0022, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges Treated Groundwater From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.

We have received and reviewed your July 20, 2009, letter requesting termination of your coverage under General NPDES Permit No. CAG914001 because you have completed groundwater cleanup activities to remove tetrachloroethylene (PCE). Therefore, Order No. R4-2007-0022 is no longer suitable for your operation. You will continue to operate a groundwater dewatering system to protect the integrity of the building structure from rising groundwater. In our letter dated July 29, 2009, we determined that your discharge is more appropriately regulated under General NPDES Permit CAG994004 and issued you Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008, which also serves as your NPDES permit. Therefore, your authorization for coverage under General NPDES Permit No. CAG914001 (Order No. R4-2007-0022) which was issued to you on August 15, 2007, is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
