**TERMINATION OF WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS (WRRs) FOR JOINT
OUTFALL SYSTEM, WHITTIER NARROWS WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (ORDER NO.
88-107, FILE NO 88-40 CI NO. 6844)**

Our letter dated July 12, 2017, transmitted a copy of the tentative order, which would terminate the water reclamation requirements for the production, distribution, and reuse of recycled water for direct, non-potable applications from the Whittier Narrows Water Reclamation Plant, located at 301 North Rosemead Boulevard, El Monte, California. Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board, at a public hearing held on September 7, 2017, reviewed the tentative order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2017-0177 (copy enclosed) relative to the termination of Order No. 88-107.

**TERMINATING WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS
FOR REUSE OF RECYCLED WATER**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

1. The Regional Water Board issued Water Reclamation Requirements Order No. 88-107, readopted in Order No. 97-02, (WRRs) - for the Whittier Narrows Water Reclamation Plant, operated by the Joint Outfall System (Discharger). The WRRs regulate the production, distribution, and reuse of recycled water for direct, non-potable applications.
2. The Discharger has now enrolled under the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order No. WQ 2016-0068-DDW, *Water Reclamation Requirements for Recycled Water Use* that regulates the production, distribution, and reuse of recycled water for direct, non-potable applications.
3. Therefore, the individual WRRs are no longer necessary and should be terminated.
4. The following Orders are hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

The Regional Water Board has notified the Discharger, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of the WRRs and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments.

The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following water reclamation requirements be terminated:
