WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NPDES PERMIT - THE DIAL CORPORATION LOCATED AT 5832 S. GARFIELD AVENUE, CITY OF COMMERCE, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0062022, CI-6984)

Our letter dated April 26,1999, transmitted the tentative requirements for your waste discharge.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on May 27, 1999, reviewed the tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. 99-045 (copy attached). This Order serves as permit under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), and expires on April 10, 2004. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of this Order. Your first monitoring report under this program is due by July 15, 1999. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File CI-6984 and NPDES No. CA0062022" which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. We will appreciate it if you would not combine other reports but would submit each type of report as a separate document.
