## RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- 1. This Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No. 93-022 for Acton Plaza and Shopping Center on February 18, 1993.
- 2. In December 2006, Acton Investments, Inc. took over the ownership of Acton Plaza and Shopping Center and renamed the facility Acton Plaza. Regional Board staff verified by file review and an inspection that Acton Investments, Inc. meets the requirements to be enrolled under General WDR Order No. 01-031
- 3. On August 20, 2008, this Regional Board enrolled Acton Plaza Investments, Inc. (Discharger) under General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Commercial and Multifamily Residential Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems, Order No. 01-031.
- 4. The Board finds that the requirements of Order No. 93-022 are no longer applicable and shall be rescinded.
- 5. The rescission of WDRs is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

This Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of Order No. 93-022 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations. This Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the Order.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board is authorized, and she is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefor, or may request same.
