ORDER NO. 01-134

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

- 1. This Regional Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the dischargers listed below.
- 2. These dischargers have since terminated their waste discharge or have not had any discharge from their facility since issuance of the waste discharge requirements.
- 3. Board staff has verified, by inspection, that this facility has discontinued discharging or there is no waste being discharged.
- 4. The Board finds that these requirements are no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
- 5. The Board has transmitted copies of this tentative Order to the dischargers and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind requirements at a public meeting to be held on September 19, 2001.
- 6. At that public meeting, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.
