TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), finds:

- 1. The Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) contained in Order No. 98-064 for the Estate of Albert Levinson, d.b.a. Brea Canon Oil Company, on August 3, 1998, for the land-treatment of petroleum-hydrocarbon-contaminated soil at the Dominguez Hills Oil Fields in the City of Carson and the Wilmington Oil Fields in the City Los Angeles, both in Los Angeles County, California (Sites). In June 2000, 75 acres of land of the Callender Leases in the Dominguez Hills Oil Fields, located at 17810 Central Avenue, Carson, was transferred to K. Hovnanian Companies of Southern California (KHCSC). All the land-treatment units that ever operated under the WDRs were located on those 75 acres.
- 2. All land-treatment activities under the WDRs were completed prior to 2003. Regional Board staff issued Closure/No Further Action letters for various lots in the Callender Leases, including all areas that had been used for land-treatment, on June 16, 2000, August 24, 2000, April 18, 2003, and January 26, 2004. Those lots have been fully developed since then.
- 3. In a letter dated April 10, 2009, the Discharger informed Regional Board staff that no further land-treatment of contaminated soil under the WDRs was expected and requested that the WDRs be terminated. In a letter dated April 29, 2010, KHCSC concurred with the Discharger's request.
- 4. During an inspection conducted on April 15, 2010, Regional Board staff observed no land-treatment activities and no violations of the WDRs at the Sites.
- 5. The Regional Board finds that WDR Order No. 98-064 is no longer applicable and should be terminated.
- 6. The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider termination of Order No. 98-064 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations. The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.
