**FINAL ORDER - TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMER HUGHES MISSILE SYSTEMS COMPANY, 8433 FALLBROOK AVENUE, CANOGA PARK, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2010-0162, CI-7483)**



TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, (Regional Board) finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 95-012 for Raytheon Company (Discharger) on January 23, 1995 for discharge of treated groundwater to groundwater basins in the Los Angeles Region at former Hughes Missile Systems Company located at 8433 Fallbrook Avenue, Canoga Park.,
2. On June 30, 2010, Discharger notified this Regional Board that the Discharger has ceased its discharge to groundwater basins.
3. The Board finds that the WDR Order No. 95-012 is no longer applicable and shall be terminated.
4. The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider termination of Order No. 95-012 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations. The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 95-012 be terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board is authorized, and he is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies that request it.
