TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—G & K MANAGEMENT COMPANY, LLC, GRAND PROMENADE, 255 S. GRAND AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-7611)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. Order No. R4-2003-0111, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have reviewed your August 18, 2009, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained a permit from City of Los Angeles to discharge groundwater into sanitary sewer system and that the groundwater discharge from the subject site to the Los Angeles River has been ceased.

On August 25, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
