PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Coast Packing Company produces edible oil by extracting oil from meat fat and packages the produced oil. Groundwater from an on-site well and potable water from the City water supply system are used as non-contact cooling water for its compressors. Coast Packing Company discharges the cooling wastewater to a storm drain.

VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE

Coast Packing Company has been discharging up to 100,000 gallons per day of wastewater. The wastewater is discharged to a storm drain located at Outfall No. 1 (Latitude 34° 00' 45", Longitude 118° 13' 15"), and it flows to the Los Angeles River, a water of the United States.

FREQUENCY OF DISCHARGE

The discharge will occur twelve hours each day, during working hours only.

REUSE OF WATER

There are no feasible reuse options for the discharge.
