**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—GOLDEN STATE WATER COMPANY—TRURO IRON AND MANGANESE FILTRATION PLANT, 11305 TRURO AVENUE, INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI-8027)**

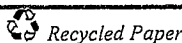
The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 98-055, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Nonprocess Wastewaters not Requiring Treatment Systems to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 29, 1998.

We have received and reviewed your October 24, 2007, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have stopped pumping of groundwater from the above referenced facility and have ceased discharge of groundwater from the facility to the Dominguez Channel.

On October 31, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Dominguez Channel. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. 98-055, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994003, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.


