TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – WORLD OIL MARKETING COMPANY, STATION NO. 17, 1460 SOUTH LA CIENEGA BLVD., LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8167)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your June 22, 2006, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have tied the groundwater treatment system to the sanitary sewer system, and that you have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject facility to Ballona Creek.

On February 13, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Ballona Creek. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
