## WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND TIME SCHEDULE ORDER FOR THE MALIBU CREEK PRESERVATION COMPANY, LLC. (File No. 00-066)

Our letter of January 3, 2001, transmitted tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) including Monitoring and Reporting Program, and a Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the Malibu Creek Plaza.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public meeting held on January 11, 2001, reviewed the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and the tentative Time Schedule Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order Nos. 01-010 and 01-011 (copies attached) relative to this discharge. Standard Provisions, which are a part of the WDRs, are also enclosed.

You are required to implement Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 8226 on the effective date of Order No. 01-010. Your first monitoring report under these Requirements is due to this Regional Board by April 15, 2001. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit.

Please reference all monitoring reports to our Compliance File No. CI-8226. We would appreciate if you would not combine other reports, such as progress or technical reports, with your monitoring reports.

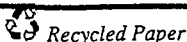
