**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER, SEPULVEDA TRUNK LINE PROJECT, SEPULVEDA STREET NEAR PARTHENIA STREET, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-8245)**

Dear Ms. Rubin:

The subject discharge is regulated under R4-2004-0109, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.


We have reviewed your August 11, 2009, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the construction project and that the discharge from the subject facility to the storm drain has been ceased.

On March 3, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109, General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001, for the facility is hereby terminated.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
