**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT — ATLANTIC RICHFIELD COMPANY—FORMER ARCO STATION NO. 1860, 3817 W. THIRD STREET, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8265)**

In our letter dated August 28, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General NPDES Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed the March 30, 2007, letter from your consultant, SECOR International Inc., requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. It is our understanding that you have ceased discharge of treated groundwater from the subject facility.

On April 3, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
