GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL COMMERCIAL SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS – RIO CAFÉ, 9411 SOLEDAD CANYON ROAD, SANTA CLARITA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 01-055, CI-8284)

We have completed our review of your application for a permit to discharge wastewater under the Waste Discharge Requirements.

Regional Board staff have reviewed the information provided and have determined that the proposed discharge meets the conditions specified in Order No. 01-031, "General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Commercial and Multifamily Residential Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems," adopted by this Regional Board on February 22, 2001. Refer to attached Fact Sheet.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, consisting of Order No. 01-031 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8284

These Waste Discharge Requirements become effective upon receipt by the Regional Board of written confirmation of acceptance of responsibility by the Discharger. The Discharger is the entity or agency accepting permanent responsibility for the Waste Discharge Requirements and the Monitoring and Reporting Program for the commercial subsurface sewage disposal system. In addition, the Discharger shall provide a copy of documentation that all property owners identified within 500 feet of the subject site were notified of application for the above General Waste Discharge Requirements. The Board must receive the documentation within two weeks from the date of this letter. If the Board does not receive it within this time period, your Waste Discharge Requirements may be withdrawn.

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8284", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
