TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR RIO CAFÉ & GROCERIES, 9411 SOLEDAD CANYON ROAD, SANTA CLARITA, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. 01-031, FILE NO. 01-055, CI-8284)

Rio Cafe and Groceries, located at 9411 Soledad Canyon Road, Santa Clarita, was enrolled in a general permit for small domestic wastewater discharges (Order No. 01-031) on June 5, 2001. In response to your concerns regarding the applicability of the general permit to your small flow, 20 gallons per day, your case has been reviewed. Due to the deminimus flow, your site is now being considered as administratively inactive.

The inactive status shall be in effect while the Regional Board determines the status of deminimus flows for small commercial facilities as part of its review of onsite wastewater systems within local jurisdictions. Consequently your discharge coverage under Board Order No. 01-031 for the facility is hereby terminated. However, the Executive Officer may reactivate your enrollment depending on the outcome of the review of diminimus flows.
