**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

Pleasant Valley Recreation & Park District (The District) operates a groundwater treatment system at 380 Skyway Drive, Camarillo (See Figure 1 for the site location). The primary contaminant in groundwater beneath the site is methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE). The treatment system includes three granulated activated carbon (GAC) vessels connected in series (See Figure 2 for treatment process). The treated groundwater from the site is discharged into a nearby storm channel under the General NPDES Permit CAG834001, Order No. R4-2002-0125. On July 23, 2007, the District submitted a complete Notice of Intent Form to continue enrollment under the general NPDES permit. Order No. R4-2007-0021 supersedes Order No. R4-2002-0125 and continues the facility enrollment under the General NPDES permit.

**VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE:**

Approximately 7,200 gallons per day of groundwater is discharged from the facility to Discharge Point 1 (Latitude: 34° 12' 35", Longitude: 119° 04' 58"). The discharge flows into Revolon Slough, thence to Calleguas Creek, a water of the United States.


**FREQUENCY OF DISCHARGE:**

The groundwater discharge will be intermittent for the duration of the treatment system operation.

**REUSE OF WATER:**

Offsite disposal of treated groundwater is not feasible due to high cost of disposal. It is not feasible to discharge the treated groundwater to the sanitary sewer system. Since there are no feasible reuse options, the groundwater is discharged into the storm channel in compliance with the requirements of the attached order.
