### WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR HOTUBS, INC., PUDDINGSTONE HOT TUBS RESORT, 1777 CAMPERS VIEW ROAD, SAN DIMAS, CALIFORNIA (File No. 01-137)

Our letter of March 11, 2002 transmitted revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements/Water Recycling Requirements (WDRs/WRRs) for your discharge of graywater from 16 existing spas and 5 additional spas to on-site landscape irrigation fields.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public meeting held on March 28, 2002, reviewed the revised tentative WDRs/WRRs, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2002-0077 (copies attached) relative to this discharge. Standard Provisions, which are a part of the WDRs/WRRs, are also enclosed.

You are required to implement Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8391 on the effective date of Order No. R4-2002-0077. Your first monitoring report under these Requirements is due to this Regional Board by July 15, 2002. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit.

Please reference all monitoring reports to Compliance File No. CI-8391. We would appreciate if you would not combine other reports, such as progress or technical reports, with your monitoring reports.
