TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – VENTURA COUNTY WATERSHED PROTECTION DISTRICT, SANTA CLARA DRAIN - UNIT IID/LOS ANGELES DRAIN UNIT I, ALONG SANTA CLARA AVENUE AND LOS ANGELES AVENUE, UNINCORPORATED AREA OF VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8394)

In our letter dated August 9, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your February 22, 2006, letter requesting termination of coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the construction of reinforced cement concrete culvert at the above referenced site and that no groundwater was discharged from this site during the construction project.

On April 18, 2006, Board staff inspected the site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
