TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – J & M OIL COMPANY, STATION NO. 33, 11515 ATLANTIC AVENUE, LYNWOOD (NPDES CAG834001, CI-8402)

In our letter dated July 9, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In your letter dated April 20, 2006, you informed Regional Board staff that the treatment system at the above-referenced facility has been shutdown since January 17, 2006, and that it will no longer be operated. Therefore, you requested termination of your coverage under the general NPDES permit. On August 4, 2006, our staff inspected the facility, and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the project to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0125 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
