TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF CERRITOS—CORPORATE YARD, 16540 MARQUARDT AVENUE, CERRITOS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-8522)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On August 3, 2007, you submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) Form and the analytical results of representative groundwater samples from your facility to continue enrollment under the General NPDES permit. Based on the information submitted, Board staff has determined that the groundwater discharge from your facility is more appropriately regulated under General NPDES Permit No. CAG914001, Order No. R4-2007-0022, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.

On October 2, 2007, NPDES Permit No. CAG914001, Order No. R4-2007-0022 with a revised Monitoring and Reporting Program was issued to City of Cerritos for the discharge of groundwater from the cleanup project into the Coyote Creek. Since the existing permit has been superseded by Order No. R4-2007-0022, coverage under NPDES Permit No. CAG834001, Order No. R4-2002-0125 for the subject facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.


