TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ATLANTIC RICHFIELD COMPANY, ARCO STATION #0194, 5884 WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-8524)

Dear Mr. Fah:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0012, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.

We have reviewed your May 21, 2009, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the groundwater cleanup project and that the discharge from the subject facility to the Ballona Creek has been ceased.

On February 2, 2011, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to the Ballona Creek. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0012, General NPDES Permit No. CAG834001, for the facility is hereby terminated.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
