**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS, FIRE STATION NO. 3, 180 S. DOHENY DRIVE, BEVERLY HILLS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-8555)**

In our letter dated March 19, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on July 11, 2002, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed the February 6, 2006, Fourth Quarter 2005 Monitoring Report from your consultant, Lindmark Engineering. You have requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. It is our understanding that you have not discharged groundwater from the subject facility since September 12, 2005.

On November 14, 2006, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0125, General NPDES Permit No. CAG834001 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
