**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—FORMER RAPID GAS STATION #19, 10211 EAST ALONDRA BOULEVARD, BELLFLOWER, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8602)**

In our letter dated February 6, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.


We have received and reviewed your August 28, 2007, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated the project has been completed and you have not discharged groundwater from the subject facility since August 7, 2007.

On November 8, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of treated groundwater from the project to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
